











This is to bring to your kind notice that the under signed Unions and Associations have represented to form the Pay Revision Negotiating Committee before end of November 2013 for New Wage Agreement to be concluded before 01.04.2014, which will be applicable for the period 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2018. Till date there is no response from the management in this regard.

Needless to mention that, formation of Pay Revision Committee is a routine affair and need to be completed early as the consequential actions will take lot of time. Of late, it is noticed that the managements are casual in their approach and not paying required attention to the stake holders. Thus the importance of the sector and Industrial peace is in jeopardy. The consumers and the Government will be put to inconvenience due to the indifference of the managements.

Therefore all the undersigned Unions and Associations hereby opined that the Pay Revision Negotiating Committee shall be constituted immediately. Being responsible Unions and Associations, we request the managements to atleast realize their responsibility now and act. If no such committee is formed before the end of December' 2013, we are left with no option but to resort to agitational approach without further notice. The managements alone are squarely responsible for disturbance in Industrial Peace and Harmony and Ultimately the Consumer and State.
