Sub: APSEBEA Final allocation of employees between power utilities of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana states—Abnormal delay—Intervention—Requested-reg.

About 1253 employees who have been working in Telangana State prior to the appointed date as on 02.06.2014, have been relieved on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2015 unilaterally and they are facing uncertain future.

As the complete, bifurcation process of the employees in power utilities could not happen these relieved employees are unable to get their legitimate posting in either of the states.

It is to submit that after relief, as per the order of Hon'ble High Court these employees have joined in the same place from where they have been relieved off. But they have been deprived of their duties even after lapse of 19 months and their future appears very bleak and grim. They keep pursuing out on this, for their duties.

In this connection, this association would like to bring the following few lines for kind perusal of both governments of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Then Energy Dept. Of Govt of Andhra Pradesh has issued orders before the appointed day (i.e 2-6-2014) allotting certain posts and employees on a orders to serve" basis for smooth functioning of Power Utilities in both the states.

In Order to have final allocation of employees as per the provisions of AP re-Organisation Act.2014, the Chairman and Managing Director, AP Transco suggested for constituting a committee, Comprising members from AP Transco and TS Transco and requested for nomination of members from TS Transco for forming the Joint Committee.

There was protracted correspondence happened between AP Transco and TS Transco in connection with the allocation of the employees to power utilities of both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States.

- The CMD, AP Transco proposed a meeting of Joint Committee consisting members of AP Transco and TS Transco for preparing guidelines for final allocation of employees between the two Corporations on 30.05.2015.
- The CMD, TS Transco vide letter dated 29.05.2015 informed that, the issue of final allocation of employees was referred to the Govt. Of Telangana and instructions are awaited. Hence could not attend the meeting to be held on 30.05.2015 by AP Transco.
- On 10.06.2015, about 1253 no's of employees from Telangana State Power Utilities whose nativity said to be Andhra Pradesh were relieved suddenly from TS Power Utilities without any notice to the individual or to AP Power Utilities.
- Annoyed by this, the relieved employees' filed writ petitions in the Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Hyderabad and the Hon'ble High Court in its orders dt 22.09.2015, suspended the relief orders of TS Power Utilities
- In fact division of employees has to be carried out within one year as per Section.82 of AP Reorganisation Act. 2014.
- On 18.03.2016, a committee headed by Justice DM. Dharmdikari, a former judge of Supreme Court has been constituted by the High Court to sort out all pending issues, pursuant to the AP Reorganization Act. 2014.
- Supreme Court on 08.04.2016 ordered Telangana State to ensure that full salary has to be paid to the employees who are working with the respective power utilities of Telangana State.
- Later the committee headed by Sri D.M. Dharmadikari, Former Judge, Supreme Court of India, Submitted its report for the consideration of the Hon'ble High Court.
- In view of the above circumstances, it appears that the chances of bifurcation of employees are very grim, unless there is mutual understating between the managements of both the states (Which inturn depends on the consent of both governments of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States.

At Present the situation of relieved employees is so pathetic that their psychological status is deteriorating day-by-day due to insecurity. Further some of the employees attained superannuation the detail of which are shown below.

Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers, etc., who were till recent past used to be respected by all are now facing utter humiliation and have been deprived of their social status due to improper handling of employees division. They are highly designated officers and now have to give their attendance at the entrance gate, and have to wait in a hall/wander in streets. These officers are now unable to move in the society for the discrimination which is not less than the apartheid.

It is very pity to note that members of relived employees (especially women employees at the Genco Quarters) were isolated from attending on the occasion of festivals, social gatherings etc., They have lost their promotions as per the seniority as on

01.06.2014 and there is a huge loss of dignity, as they can neither stay nor can move to the employee society.

Everybody such as management, Public representatives, Associations, Media etc., are paying lip sympathy and there are no constructive efforts to resolve the problem. Mental agony and frustration of those employees expressed with us is listed below for perusal .

"మేము ఏం తప్పు చేశామని మాకీ శిక్ష?"

(*"What wrong we have done for getting punished like this?"*)

"క్వార్టర్స్ లో కరెంట్ లేకపోయినా, వాటర్ రాకపోయినా పట్టించుకోవడం లేదు"

(*"No Electriciy, No Water for our quarters, nobody is taking care of this"*)

"పండుగలకి, పబ్బాలకి ఆంధ్రా వాళ్ళని పిలుపులకు కూడ నోచుకోవడం లేదు"

(*"Nobody is calling Andhra Natives (Relived Employees) for Festivals and Functions"*)

"అంకిత భావంతో పని చేసిన మేము అవమానభారంతో, సిగ్గుతో ఇంటి నుండి బయటకు

రాలేకపోతున్నాము."

(*"While on the duty we have done work with dedication and now we are having a fear of coming out of houses due to the ill treatment and humiliation"*)

Excepting the 1253 relieved employees said to be native of Andhra Pradesh, Relieved from Telangana Power Utilities all other employees of both the states after bifurcation of the state in to two states, are leading their normal duties and whereas these relieved employees for no fault of them are suffering with severe hardship, experiencing mental agony, humiliation and unrest.

In this connection Hon'ble Chief Secretary is requested to intervene empathetically and prevail upon the concerned Govt. machinery to rescue the relieved employees form the existing state of affairs (from 11<sup>th</sup> June 2015) and arrange to complete the bifurcation of employees and allot them to the respective power utilities of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States at the earliest, so that relived employees from the Telangana state can be brought back to the normal office duty.

For which act of kindness, this association will be very grateful to you sir.
