Sub: Bifurcation of employees between Residual Andhra
Pradesh and Telangana State – Certain concerns - Reg.

This has reference to the issues pertaining to the bifurcation of employees, assets and liabilities. Recently some disturbing incidents have taken place which are brought to your notice for kind necessary action.

- The APSEB Engineers' Association wishes to bring to your kind notice that some engineers belonging to Telangana region of Warangal circle belonging to TS TRANSCO are visiting various offices of TS TRANSCO during office hours and threatening some Engineers stating that they belong to A.P. region, behaving rudely using filthy language asking them either to go on leave or resign their posts. They are collecting letters from them forcibly stating that they are opting to go to Andhra Region and they may be allotted or Transferred immediately.
- You may recall that on similar pretext (that they shall be transferred to A.P. on their request) some Junior Plant Attendants were relieved of their posts from KTPS and KTPP who are appointed on non-local basis in district employment selection. No body knows how much these employees and their families are suffering. No action is taken on the persons responsible for this type of incidents.

- It is not known on what basis the nativity of all the employees working in Telangana State are published on net in the official web site. Surprisingly the native place is not displayed but shown as Telangana or A.P. What is the purpose of displaying the list of employees in Telangana on regional basis, the managements need to give an explanation, which shall be published on the same page of the list. Such of these actions are emboldening the errant elements who are publicly going to the Offices and threatening the officers in the office timings. These items are reported in PRESS also. The managements or the constitutional authorities who are expected to react or respond on such incidents are pretending as if everything is normal and shedding their responsibilities. **There is actually constitutional break-down. The officials are denied their fundamental rights of peaceful living and working atmosphere.**
- It is sincerely felt that the managements should put an end to this anarchy and rule of land be restored. **The A.P. Power Sector Management and Telangana Power Sector managements shall sit together and formulate the guidelines for bifurcation of employees , assets and liabilities amicably as per the AP Re-organisation act. If the managements can not resolve this , then they should seek the intervention of an arbitrator or the Central Government.**
- The managements shall ensure that the energies of the employees on both sides shall be focused totally on the development of the Power Sectors in the respective States and a congenial working atmosphere be created. The power sector in both the states have huge task on hand and the Master "the consumer" need better service.
