Sub: APSEBEA - Elections for the term 2026-28 - Representation of Er. D. Sreedhar, Dy.EE/TI (Member ID: 306) on Registered Bye-Laws and his nomination - Clarification and necessary action - Requested - Reg.

1. The undersigned was appointed Returning Officer vide reference (1), and the elections are being conducted as per the Bye-Laws furnished by your office at reference (2), read with the General Body resolution that elections shall be conducted "in accordance with the earlier practice and Bye-laws".
2. Er. D. Sreedhar, vide references (4) and (6), has sought a certified copy of the "Registered Bye-Laws (with Stamp & Date)" and contends that (a) the Approved Bye-Laws should not be applied for validation of nominations; (b) the registered Bye-Laws contain no clause barring a member of a Co-operative Society/Stores Management Committee from contesting; and (c) he held the post of Branch Secretary, Dr. NTPS, during 2020-23 while being a member of the Stores Management Committee.
3. In this regard, it is submitted that:
 - (i) The Returning Officer is not the custodian of the Association's records. As per Clause 11(III) of the Bye-Laws, the Secretary General keeps all records and produces them to members. The registration status of the Bye-Laws and the furnishing of a certified copy are, therefore, matters for your office.
 - (ii) The nomination was examined under Clause 8(IX)(d), which bars a member holding a post in a Co-operative Society (Stores in Generating Stations) from becoming an office-bearer unless he resigns before filing the nomination and encloses proof of resignation. Clause 18(c) also applies.
 - (iii) The member questions whether Registered Bye-Laws exist, yet claims to have examined a copy bearing the Registrar's stamp and date. The authenticity of such a copy needs to be verified by the Association.

4. Since the basis of the elections itself has been questioned, and the matter may go before a legal forum, you are requested to:

- (a) confirm in writing the registration status of the Bye-Laws (Regd. No.874/1975), including whether the 2018-19 amendments were filed with the Registrar of Societies, and furnish a certified copy, if available;
- (b) confirm that the Bye-Laws at reference (2) are the governing Bye-Laws for the present elections;
- (c) take such further action as deemed necessary to avoid any complications in the conduct of the elections.

5. Any consequences arising out of the above issues shall be dealt with by the Association itself.

6. As the last date for withdrawal is **24-09-2026** and the final list is due on **25-09-2026**, the above may be furnished **on or before 24-09-2026**. If no reply is received by the due date, it shall be construed that the Bye-Laws at reference (2) are legally valid and binding, and the election process shall continue as per the notified schedule.

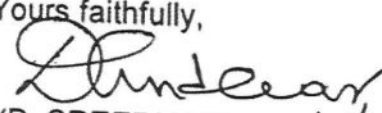

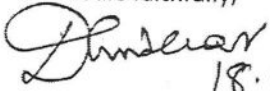

Subject: Request for Clear Confirmation and Certified Copy of Registered Bye-Laws of APSEBAEA (With Stamp & Date) (Regd. No. 874/1975).

Sir,

Vide the ref cited above your reply is not clear and does not specifically answer the question raised by me. I had specifically requested a **certified copy of the Registered Bye-Laws (Date & Stamp)**, and not a copy of the approved Bye-Laws.

Therefore, the question is very simple and specific:

Do the Registered Bye-Laws of APSEB Engineers' Association (APSEBAEA), Regd. No. 874/1975, actually exist or not?

The response provided so far does not answer the specific question raised. The existence of approved Bye-Laws does not, by itself, establish the existence of Registered Bye-Laws.

I therefore request you to provide a clear and categorical answer:

1. **If the Registered Bye-Laws(Stamp & Date) exist, kindly provide a certified copy of the same, along with the relevant registration particulars.**
2. **If no Registered Bye-Laws exist, kindly state so clearly and categorically in writing.**

I request that the specific question raised may kindly be answered directly, without referring to or providing the approved Bye-Laws in place of the Registered Bye-Laws.

Subject: Representation against proposed invalidation of my nomination –
Request to permit me to contest the APSEB Engineers association elections.
Reference: Lr. No Returning Officer/APSEB Elections, D.No 6/2026 dt 21.09.2026.

Vide reference cited above, I, (D.Sreedhar) respectfully submit that I had specifically requested a certified copy of the Registered Bye-Laws of the APSEB Engineers Association. However, instead of furnishing the registered Bye-Laws (with stamp & date), a copy of the approved Bye-Laws are provided to me, these are not the same documents, and my specific request for the Registered Bye-Laws has therefore not been complied with. Approved By-Laws should not be considered for validation of nominations.

I further submit that, upon examination of the registered Bye-Laws (with stamp & date) authorised of register of societies, there is no clause prohibiting a member of the Cooperative Society/Stores Management Committee from contesting the elections of the APSEB Engineers Association. Therefore, there appears to be no Bye-Law-based disqualification applicable to my candidature on this ground.

I have also previously served as Branch Secretary of the APSEB Engineers Association, Dr. NTPS Branch, from 2020 to 2023, while simultaneously being a member of the Stores Management Committee. My holding of both positions during that period was not treated as a disqualification from contesting or holding the Association post.

In these circumstances, the objection raised against my nomination and the declaration that my nomination is invalid appear to be without any specific supporting provision in the Registered Bye-Laws. I therefore request that my nomination should not be rejected or invalidated merely on the basis of such an objection.

Accordingly, I request you to:

1. Provide a certified copy of the Registered Bye-Laws of APSEB Engineers Association (Regd. No. 874/1975), if such Registered Bye-Laws exist.
1. Identify the specific clause/rule in the Registered Bye-Laws under which my nomination is alleged to be invalid.
2. Until such specific statutory/Bye-Law provision is established, do not invalidate my nomination.
3. Permit me to contest the APSEB Engineers Association Elections (Term 2026-2028) in accordance with the applicable rules.

I request that my nomination be considered strictly in accordance with the Registered Bye-Laws and applicable election rules, and not on the basis of an unsupported or malicious objection.

I trust that a fair and reasoned decision will be taken in accordance with the governing rules and principles of natural justice.
